Tour Itinerary:

Day 1 / (Airport/ Chilaw (60 KMS /1 Hrs 30 Min) Chilaw /Dambulla (140 Kms / 3Hrs) Morning Flights Preferred)

Dambulla

Upon arrival at the Colombo Bandaranaike International Airport, you will be received warmly by our representative. You will then be escorted to your vehicle to begin your holiday in Sri Lanka. Chilaw: Located almost 2 hours away, North of Colombo, Chilaw offers you a perfect holiday destination with its beautiful lagoon, turquoise dazzling ocean with an abundance of marine life, mangrove- fringed lakes, golden sun kissed beaches filtered by coconut trees, luxury accommodation and significant



places of worship. Chilaw's significance does not end there as it is also the home town of two freedom fighters. Charles Corea and Victor Corea that fought for Sri Lanka's independence during the colonial days. This has made Chilaw famous for its three Cs - Coconuts, Crabs and Coreas. Places you will be visiting in Chilaw. • Munneswaram Hindu Temple • ManavariKovil • Suvisuddharmaya Buddhist Temple • Chilaw Silver Beach Sigiriya (UNESCO World Heritage Site) • The rocky outcrop of Sigiriya holds the ancient remains of King Kassapa's palace from the 5th century AD. The top is reachable by stairs built on the side of the mountain and features the Lion Rock and the remains of the palace and fortress. Visitors will see the magnificence of the place when they reach the top, complete with a 360-degree view of the jungle below. The water reservoirs that collect rainwater are still there and in good condition. Sigiriya was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1982. Dambulla (UNESCO World Heritage Site) • The Golden Dambulla Cave Temple has been a pilgrimage destination for the past 22 centuries. It's also the largest and best- preserved cave temple on the island (there are others). The Dambulla Cave Temple was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1991 in order to preserve the magnificent wall paintings and over 150 statues in and around the temple. Places you will be visiting in Dambulla • Dambulla Cave Temple • Kandalama Reservoir • Sigiriya Lion Rock Fortress • Overnight Stay at Hotel in Dambulla.

Day 2 / (Dambulla /Trincomalee (110 KMS / 2 Hrs) One Way) Trincomalee

Breakfast at the Hotel Trincomalee Trincomalee, one of the finest natural deep-water harbours in the world is located 257 km north-east of Colombo, which is considered as the commercial hub of Sri Lanka. Trincomalee is home to the fine beaches of Nilaveli, Uppuveli, Kuchchaveli and the off-shore Pigeon Island. Recently Trincomalee has become popular as a Whale Watching destination as well. The Dive centres at Nilaveli and Uppuveli offer touriststhe opportunity to enjoy their holidays in diving, snorkeling and swimming. The Trincomalee district, referred as Gokanna or Gokarna in the historical chronicles and inscriptions, is studded with a multitude of ruins of ancient Buddhist temples and is considered a major Buddhist cultural and archaeological site of Sri Lanka. The seven hot springs at Kanniyalocated a mere 8km from Trincomalee attract regular crowds throughout the year in view of the therapeutic properties of the water as well as the varying temperatures from one well to the other. Places you will be visiting in Trincomalee. • Koneswaram Hindu Temple • Fort Fredrick Portuguese Fortress • Tincomalee British War Cemetery • Kanniya Hot Water Spring • Pigeon Island National Park Overnight Stay at Hotel in Dambulla.



Day 3 / (Dambulla / Kandy (85 Kms / 2 Hrs 30 Min)) Kandy

Breakfast at the Hotel Kandy (UNESCO World Heritage Site) Kandy, a mountain city in Sri Lanka, was home to the Sinhalese kings from 1592 to 1815. It is also the site of Sri DaladaMaligawa, also called the Temple of the Tooth, as a special container holds a tooth of the Buddha. Over the years, the relic came to be very important politically; the belief was that the holder of the sacred tooth was the one who would have power over the Buddhist population. The Sacred City of Kandy was appointed the status of World Heritage Site in 1988, mainly due to the Temple of the Tooth. Places you will be visiting in Kandy. • Spice Garden Visit (Complementary) – en route • Temple of the sacred tooth relic • Royal botanical garden • Gem Museum • Cultural Dance Show Overnight Stay at Hotel in Kandy.

Day 4 / (Kandy / Nuwara Eliya (85KMS/3 Hrs 30 Min)) Nuwara Eliya

Breakfast at the Hotel Nuwara Eliya The 'Little England' of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of Mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantations. Samuel Baker, the discoverer of Lake Albert and the explorer of the Nile in 1846, founded the city. It is supposed to be one of the coldest places on the island, but is really just like an England spring day although the temperature does drop at night. Many of the buildings retain features from the colonial period such as the Queen's Cottage, Grand Hotel, Hill club, Post office etc... Town attractions include the golf course, trout streams, Victoria park, and boating on Lake Gregory. Places to visit: Horton Plains National Park, Ramboda Waterfalls, Hakgala Botanical Garden, Pedro Tea Factory, Moon Plains, Seetha Amman Temple, Pink Post Office, New Zealand Farm – Ambewela. Places you will be visiting in Nuwara Eliya • Ramboda Waterfalls. • Ramboda Hanuman Temple. • Tea Factory visit. • Gregory Lake. • Hakgala Botanical Garden. • Seethab Amman Temple. • Pink Post Office. Overnight Stay at Hotel in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 5 / (Nuwara Eliya /Colombo (170 Kms /4 Hrs 30 Min)) Colombo

Breakfast at the Hotel Colombo Tour will begin from the Fort area of Colombo which has been named fort because of it being a fort during the times of Portuguese and Dutch. Later we will take you to Colombo National Museum to see some of the great specimens of arts crafts and archeology of Colombo. You will drive thru the commercial areas and drive past Pettah, a colorful Oriental bazaar with a mix of people, ancient vehicles, bargains, mosques and temples. You have a chance to see a Hindu Temple, Buddhist Temple and the Jami Ul Alfar Jumma Mosque of Colombo. Continue your tour of Colombo through the Wolfendhal Dutch Church, Hulftsdorp Law Courts as you drive along the residential area of Cinnamon Gardens, and also visit the Independence Square and Bandaranayake Memorial International Conference Hall. Places you will be visiting in Colombo • Galle Face • Petah

Bazaar • Town Hall • BMICH • Colombo Museum • Independence square • Jami Ul Alfar Jumma Mosque • Gangaramaya Temple • Anjenayar Temple • KelaniyaRajamaha Viharaya. Overnight Stay at Hotel in Colombo.
